**Why Sustainability Planning?**

Sustainable community-based initiatives will enable communities at the local level to re-examine their processes and to drive improvements and efficiency in their overall operations.




**Why Sustainability Planning?**

Increases in efficiency that are the result of reductions in energy and waste generation can lead to lower emissions and significant cost savings; savings which can further sustain local government operations.
