

Bring your professional talents to MAP this year!

The Michigan Association of Planning is seeking nominations for smart, engaged, and eager board members.



The annual election for the Michigan Chapter of the American Planning Association's (MAP) **Board of Directors** is conducted each fall with the newest elected board members taking their seat at the annual meeting on Thursday, October 18th, 2012, at MAP's annual conference *Planning Michigan*.

This year there are three open seats on the MAP board, including one incumbent running for re-election. As required by Association bylaws, a nominating committee was appointed in March to nominate members for each vacancy on the board.

If you wish to be considered by the board nominating committee, submit a one-page letter of interest and a one-page resume/biography to the Nominating Committee in care of the **executive director**. Letters should include experience, interest, position statement, and specific talents that will be valuable to the board of directors.

Nominations will be accepted through July 20, 2012 (90 days prior to the annual meeting). Terms are three years, with the option of running for a second term. [Click here for board member responsibilities and information.](#)

The committee will file a written report with the board president by August 19, 2012 (60 days prior to the annual meeting). Further election information will follow, as last year bylaws were updated to allow for electronic balloting.
